11th Annual State Mid Public Links Championship
Highland National Golf Course
St. Paul, MN
June 17-18, 2017

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ELIGIBILITY: The Mid Public Links Championship is open to amateur players who are members of a club that is a member of the Minnesota Public Golf Association (MPGA) and has a current active GHIN handicap at that club. In order to play in the Mid Public Links, a player must be at least 25 years of age as of June 17, 2017.

FORMAT: The State Mid Public Links Championship is a two-day, 36-hole event. This event will be one flight stroke play (no handicap). If a tie occurs for first place, a sudden death playoff will take place. The Mid Public Links winner is exempt from qualifying for the Minnesota State Open.

Note: Tee Times for Mid Public Links players will follow tee times for Net Public Links each day.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES: Entries submitted by Postal Mail must be postmarked not later than June 3rd, 2017.

On-line registration will be available until June 7th. Accepted entries will be posted on our website www.mpga.net.

***ENTRY WITHDRAWAL AND REFUNDS:** Your entry fee will be refunded if the MPGA is notified before the close of entries. Fees will not be refunded after close of entry.

RULES: USGA rules govern all play except as amended by the Committee. Rangefinders may be used for distance measurements only. The MPGA Code of Conduct policy and dress code is in effect (reference www.mpga.net).

STARTING TIME: Pairing/starting times will be **e-mailed** to each entrant prior to the tournament with his starting time. Starting times will be posted on the MPGA web site. Please check in at the registration table at least 20 minutes prior to your tee time on Saturday, and report to your assigned starting tee, ready to play, ten minutes prior to your starting time both days. You should go directly to the tee on Sunday.

POWER CART RENTAL: Power carts are allowed, please pay for their use in Pro Shop. To reserve a cart call the Highland National Golf Course

MGA PLAYER POINTS: 1st - 50, 2nd - 40, 3rd - 30, 4th - 20, 5th - 15, 6th - 10, 7th - 5 points.
