ELIGIBILITY: The Net Public Links Championship is open to amateur players who are members of a club that is a member of the Minnesota Public Golf Association (MPGA) and has a current active GHIN handicap at that club.

FORMAT: The Net Public Links Championship is a two-day, 36-hole event. The Net-Public Links will be conducted using the Stableford format as defined in the Rules of Golf – Rule 32-Stableford Competitions. This event will have flights based on the number of entries and handicaps. Full handicaps will be applied after adjusting to the slope rating of the golf course. Your handicap index as of **closing of entries** will be used and will determine in which flight you will be placed. If a tie occurs for first place, a sudden death playoff (all flights) will take place. The Committee may adjust handicaps in accordance with USGA approved procedures. (See Knuth Points definition on www.mpga.net).

Note: Tee Times for Net Public Links Championship will be early each day.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES: Entries submitted by Postal Mail must be postmarked no later than June 3rd, 2017. On-line registration will be available until June 7th. Accepted entries will be posted on our website www.mpga.net.

* **ENTRY WITHDRAWAL AND REFUNDS:** Your entry fee will be refunded if the MPGA is notified before the close of entries. Fees will not be refunded after close of entry.

RULES: USGA rules govern all play except as amended by the Committee. Rangefinders may be used for distance measurements only. The MPGA Code of Conduct policy and dress code is in effect (reference www.mpga.net).

STARTING TIME: Pairing/starting times will be **e-mailed** to each entrant prior to the tournament with his starting time. Starting times will be posted on the MPGA web site. Please check in at the registration table at least 20 minutes prior to your tee time on Saturday, and report to your assigned starting tee, ready to play, ten minutes prior to your starting time both days. You should go directly to the tee on Sunday.

POWER CART RENTAL: Power carts are allowed, please pay for their use in Pro Shop. To reserve a cart call the Highland National Golf Course.
